The Crows sit proudly on top of the division after a good 2-0 win over a hard-working Caldicot Town side that played some good football at times. Lukman Mojeed put the Crows ahead early on with a far post header, and Abdul Kamotondo scored with an amazing 35 yard shot to seal the game in the second half.

The visitors started much the brighter on the crisp October afternoon where most of the league's clubs were concerned with Welsh Cup matters. They exerted some early pressure, but didn't trouble Jerrfries too much in the home goal.

With Caldicot starting well, it was perhaps a bit against the run of play when the Crows took the lead just after the 15-minute mark. Jean Black Ngody initiated a short corner routine, and when he got the ball back he whipped in a dangerous cross that Lukman Mojeed met at the far post with a low diving header into the empty net. This was a blow to the visitors and a fairly low-key half an hour ensued.

The second half was anything but low-key in comparison. The Crows got off to a flyer and went 2-0 up within a few minutes. After Caldicot failed to clear their lines from a spell of pressure, Mojeed laid the ball back to Abdul Kamotono who fired an unstoppable shot straight into Smallcomb's top right-hand corner from about 30-35 yards!

With Caldicot forced to attack, they became more vulnerable to the counter raid, but Smallcombe in the visitor's goal was having a good game. He pushed out a couple of shots from Ricky Hodge, before Mark McGibbon hit his shot just over after a buccaneering run down the right flank before cutting inside.

Unfortunately, Joel Pardeal saw red after an off-the-ball scuffle with Kel Stevens whilst awaiting a corner. Caldicot then threw defender Wenzel up front in an effort to get a goal back, and fair play; he had Caldicot's best chance. The ball fell kindly to Wenzel in the box, but just as he shaped to shoot, Akinbolu tackled superbly to clear the danger.

Cwmbrân subs Shadrach, and new signing from Pontypridd Abdul Rasul both had chances on the break to extend the lead, but Smallcombe continued to keep them out, while Ferreira's long-range effort went just wide.

Unfortunately, the game was halted for ten or so minutes when Andrew Wenzel fell awkwardly by the corner flag, and an ambulance had to be called. We all wish the Caldicot man a speedy recovery.
