The Crows survived an early scare to record a comfortable 6-0 victory over relegated Garw. Job Frumba's hat-trick in six minutes was the highlight of the first half, while Kone's and Guei's spectacular efforts were highlights of the second.

The hosts started well and had two good early chances. Lee Hogg was put through on goal after 15 minutes, but his shot lacked the power to beat Jeffries. Then Chris Saman saw his shot saved shortly after.

Leon Clarke came close to opening the scoring when he glanced a header wide from Ricky Hodge's right-wing cross. Then the game turned into the Job Frumba show.

Frumba had been drafted in for his first full start due to the Crows having a number of players suspended...and he certainly made an impact! After Frumba latched onto Hodge's pass, keeper Chorley saved his first shot, and his second hit the post.

Shortly after, Frumba hit the crossbar from the edge of the box, before shooting just over three minutes later. Then just before the half hour mark, he finally got on the score sheet. Leon Clarke had been put through, but keeper Chorley did well to force him wide. When Clarke attempted to turn he was tripped by a defender and the linesman signalled for a penalty kick. Frumba stepped up and sent the keeper the wrong way to make it 1-0.

Garw were then torn apart as Frumba added a second four minutes later, heading in powerfully from a Hodge cross; swiftly followed by a delightful shot from the edge of the box, after Garw failed to clear a corner. The young Cameroonian had completed a hat-trick in six minutes.

The Crows could have added to their lead before half time, but Clarke shot just wide after a neat build up involving Chime, Hodge, and Frumba; and he then saw another shot saved well by Chorley.

The second half started as the first ended, and the Crows immediately went 4-0 up. Leon Clarke took advantage of a poor headed clearance to fire home from close range.

Garw keeper Tom Chorley continued to prove how much of an asset he is to his club, as he made save after save. Before the hour mark he saved well from both Frumba and Clarke, while Ricky Hodge continually supplied the ammunition.



Frumba was unlucky to shoot just over on the hour after neatly flicking it from one foot to the other in the box before letting fly. However, Tidiany Kone obviously wanted to out-do his teammate...

A throw-in was flicked on by Kane Law, Kone then controlled the ball, flicked it over himself and his marker, and fired home a cracking shot that Chorley could do nothing about. The goal was as spectacular as it was significant, for it was the 200<sup>th</sup> league goal conceded by Garw this season.

The Crows capped a fine win five minutes from time when substitute Sosthene Guei latched onto a long ball forward. He outpaced the tired Garw defence and hit a sweet half volley passed the stranded Chorley.

The Crows move up to 11<sup>th</sup> place and now need to take the confidence gained from this performance into next Wednesday's home clash with Taffs Well.
